

# Be Inspired by those who made a difference then. Be awakened to your own power to make a difference today.

Accompanied by Rabbi Aaron Krupnick, Dr. Helene Herman Krupnick and Pastor Tracey Barnard of Impact Live Church in Cherry Hill among others, this trip will be a unique opportunity to experience the living history of the Civil Rights Movement and its leadership as well as gain a deeper understanding of Southern Jewry together with friends and community members.

Our journey begins first thing Monday morning March 10, 2025 in Atlanta, and from there travels to Birmingham, Montgomery, and Selma.

In our travels we will gain deeper understanding of the civil rights movement by meeting with participants who knew and worked with Dr. King and took part in the march from Selma to Montgomery. We will also learn about Southern Jewish life and discuss Jewish involvement in the Movement.

Traveling one month before Passover, we will explore the impact of the Torah's story of the Exodus on those who fought for Civil Rights. The lessons of both the biblical quest for freedom and the Civil Rights movement continue to inspire. Recognizing that ensuring Civil Rights is an ongoing enterprise, not simply an issue of the past, this experience will open us up to frank discussions about the power of allyship and our own legacies.

We may offer a pre-program opportunity on Sunday, March 9 to attend church services at Ebenezer Baptist Church in Atlanta, home church of both Dr. King and current pastor Senator Rev. Raphael Warnock.

We will offer programs before and after the trip to provide opportunities for the group to meet, socialize and learn together to help us better understand one another, to share our histories, and to gain appreciation for our unique experiences.



## How much will the trip cost?

As of now, the cost is \$1350 plus airfare. Participants will make their own travel arrangements. Please note, there are a few meals that you are on your own and that is not included in the fee. The single room supplement is approx. \$250 if you choose to room alone. There are discounts for rooms of 3 or 4.
